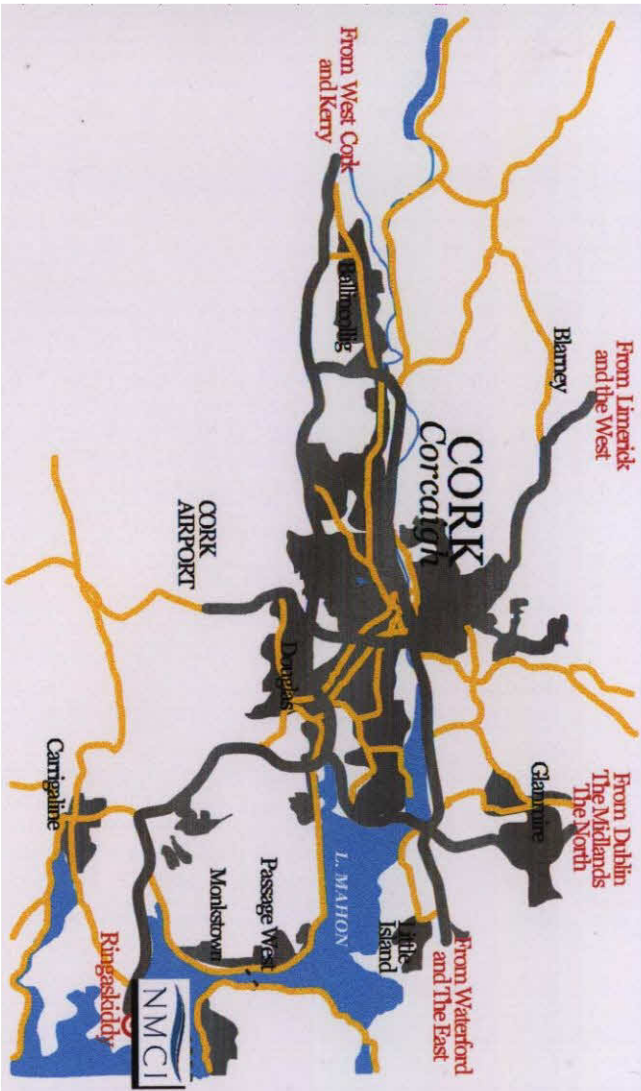

A wide range of Irish & International companies will be present to answer questions as to future careers within the industry

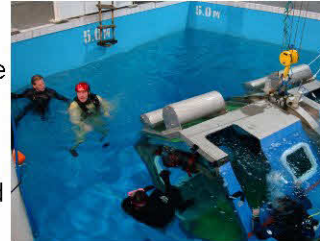

The Environmental pool
